### **Bilfinger Berger Services achieves Practical Completion at Braemar 2 Power Station**

Specialist engineering, construction and asset management contractor, Bilfinger Berger Services, has achieved Practical Completion of the Braemar 2 Power Station, near Dalby in Queensland.

Bilfinger Berger Services was granted practical completion of the final gas turbine and the balance of plant at the end of June and the station is now in full commercial operation.

The plant features three 150 MW gas turbines, generators and ancillary equipment, supplied by Siemens. The 450 MW facility is a peaking power station with the capacity to provide up to three per cent of the combined electricity requirements of Queensland and New South Wales.

As the principal contractor for the power station, Bilfinger Berger Services was responsible for the installation of the power generation equipment and the design and construction of the balance of plant. The scope of work included site infrastructure, civil work, buildings, electrical and control systems, water supply and waste treatment.

Bilfinger Berger Services specialist subsidiary, i.power solutions, designed and supplied the switchroom.

“Bilfinger Berger Services is a leading installer of gas-fired plant in Australia, with a further two facilities currently under construction in Victoria and Western Australia,” said Mark Elliott, Managing Director Bilfinger Berger Services.

“Bilfinger Berger Services’ Engineering Services business has an impressive 60-year track record and will deliver over 1.4 GW of new capacity this year.”

Bilfinger Berger Services sourced more than \$20 million of goods and services from Dalby-based subcontractors and suppliers during construction of the Braemar 2 Power Station.
